Basic Synthetic strings (£12)

Suitable for most players. No brands names to keep the cost low.
Very good value. Or Gamma Advantage.

Basic Synthetic coloured strings (£13)

Black, Blue, Green, Pink, Red, Yellow and Rainbow (multi-coloured) are available.
Re-stringing is not only for the tournament players! Have fun with Pink strings with a Pink grip!

Textured Synthetic string (£16)

Gamma Dura Spin for exceptional spin and control.
can be used for the whole racket on its own or can be used as a cross string with poly in main.

Hybrid Polyester & Synthetic (£16, 18, 22)

For tournament players and string breakers. Signum Pro plasma HEXtreme from Germany is for the main string. Unique hexagon shape for extreme bite on the ball for excellent spin and control. Durable. Cross string can be basic, textured or multifilament.

Multifilament

For those players who want the best quality, good playability, comfort, feel and arm-friendly.

When to change strings?

Get your racket re-strung as many times per year as you want:
it is recommended that if you play only once a week,
then re-string at least once a year, if you play three times a week,
then re-string three times a year, or when you break your string.
This gives you a minimum standard of string performance.
Did you spend time choosing your racket?
Now you have to look after the strings to maximise your racket performance.
Over time and with use rackets lose tension and feel/control.

What is tension?

Racket tension is the stiffness of strings.
Higher the tension the more control you get,
and lower the tension the more power generally.
This stiffness will be different depending on the type of strings,
racket type and size.
Interesting facts about the tension at the French Open 2009,
lowest tension of 22 Lbs (Italian player) and
highest tension of 77 Lbs (Melzer) are used!
Mr. Nadal uses 55 Lbs, Andy Murray and
our club coach Ross Grover uses 62 Lbs.

Which strings?

There are more than 500 strings on the market!
I have chosen a couple strings to meet all standards.
